Parents should park in the event entrance parking lot on the south side of the school.*

Tickets will be sold in the main office before school, after school, and during the students' lunch period.

Reminders when purchasing tickets...

- *Prom Registration Form must be completed before ticket can be purchased.*
- *Out-of-District Guest Form must be approved before ticket can be purchased.*
- *Cash or check (made out to SHS) accepted.*
- *Outstanding balances and fees must be paid before ticket can be purchased.*
- *No tickets will be sold after Friday, March 21st at 3:30 PM.*
- ***There will be no partial payments or refunds.***
- ***Students are required to attend Prom and Post Prom.***

PICTURES: *Photographers will be on-site to take candid photos between 6 PM and 10 PM.*

Students must be in attendance at school on Friday, May 2nd in order to attend Prom, unless absence has been approved by administration. Students are expected to meet eligibility requirements in order to attend Prom.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is Prom off campus?

Yes. We are pleased to have the opportunity to host prom at Whitetail Ridge Golf Club in Yorkville. Post-Prom will follow at Echo Lanes in Morris.

Are all students required to attend Post-Prom?

Yes. Due to transportation and safety concerns, all students are required to attend both events.

Is transportation provided?

Yes. Charter buses will leave campus at 5:00 PM and return to SHS at 12:30 AM. ALL students are required to ride the charter buses. There will be no exceptions.

Will there be time for pictures after the Grand March?

No. Grand March will begin at 4:30 PM, with students immediately boarding their designated buses after they have been announced. Please plan accordingly to have all pictures completed prior to the Grand March.

How are tickets purchased?

Students must complete a digital Prom Registration Form prior to purchasing tickets. The link is available on our website or can be accessed using the QR code to the right.



Ticket sales are earlier due to the venue needing final counts. Tickets will be sold from March 10th through March 21st in the main office before school, after school, or during the student’s lunch period. Cash or check accepted. No tickets will be sold after March 21st.

Out-of-district guest forms are digital. Guests must be approved by SHS administration before tickets will be sold. The link is available on our website or can be accessed using the QR code to the right.



Can students change between prom and post-prom?
